Program Overview

Venture Catalyst is launching the sixth cohort of Biotech Innovation Gallery (BIG) Pre-accelerator program, which provides campus innovators and UC Davis-associated startups with industry mentoring engagements, business model and investor pitch coaching, and assistance with developing marketing and investor collateral.

The pre-accelerator program culminates in the Biotech Innovation Gallery (BIG) Investor Event and Startup Showcase. The BIG pre-accelerator and Event align with the annual J.P. Morgan Healthcare Conference, the largest healthcare investment symposium in the industry, bringing together industry leaders, emerging fastgrowth companies, innovative technology creators, and members of the investment community. Campus innovators and UC Davis-associated startups are provided a platform to connect with industry experts, potential partners and investors during the BIG Investor Event and Startup Showcase and through individual partnering meetings alongside the J.P. Morgan Healthcare Conference.
